

Technical Requirements

- TIFF (.tif/.tiff), JPEG (.jpeg/.jpg), GIF (.gif) and PNG (.png) format
- Image pixel dimensions of at least 1000 pixels or larger in either height or width preferred

Naming the File

"Images submitted to Amazon must be named with the following convention: Product identifier (ASIN, ISBN, EAN or UPC) stripped of any dashes or spaces, followed by an optional 4 character variant code (MAIN, PTo1, etc), and file extension. Each of these parts must be separated by a period. Any additional characters (dashes, underscores, or spaces) will prevent the file from being processed."

Samples

- ASINs (Amazon Standard Identification Number)
- ISBN-13 (International Standard Book Number)
- EAN (European Article Number)
- JAN (Japanese Article Number)
- UPC (Universal Product Code)

Remove any spaces or dashes from the product identifier.

Must be the item not line drawing






Photos Must Be:

- In Focus not soft or pixelated from enlarging
- The item only (can use romance on second shot)
- No additional text, watermarks or promotional



No glare spots

eBay Photo Requirements

- Must be at least 500 pixels on one end (1000 or more is better)
- No borders or frames around photos
- No text with photo

Etsy Photo Requirements

- Minimum 570 pixels wide
- Maximum of 800-1000 pixels wide



Photo Requirement for Buy.com

- Images must have a light background
- Be no larger than 500 x 500 pixels
- May not be watermarked.



Depth of Field

How large or small the leaves of the lens is open will affect how much focus in front or behind the main subject – or area you are focusing on.




Depth of Field

• Aperture Priority Mode

(for automatic cameras make sure you are set to the landscape shooting mode)






Metering Mode

(center weight for white backgrounds)




Evaluative metering

This is a general-purpose metering mode suited for portraits and even backlit subjects. The camera sets the exposure automatically to suit the scene.



Partial metering

Effective when the background is much brighter than the subject due to backlighting, etc. Partial metering covers about 9.4% of the viewfinder area at the center.



Spot metering

This is for metering a specific spot of the subject or scene. The metering is weighted at the center covering about 2.3% of the viewfinder area. When spot metering is set, the spot metering circle will be displayed in the viewfinder.



Center-weighted average metering

The metering is weighted at the center and then averaged for the entire scene.

• Settings on the camera work with and affect other settings

• If you want the sharpest picture normally the F/Stop will be set at the smallest opening

• Which affects the amount of time the shutter must be open to allow in enough light create a well exposed image



• Think of it like a funnel



• A slow shutter speed means a blurry picture



Tripod For Super Sharp Pictures!



Third Part Of The Equation



ISO

Changes the sensors 'sensitivity' to light

Synchronicity = you can still have a small lens opening and a faster shutter speed (for hand held shots)

OR

(If your camera is an all point & shoot camera) you can adjust the ISO and the camera may make the lens opening smaller so you can create a greater
